New Business:

1. **City Road work** – Ron Spahlinger stated we received more material. Patchwork was performed on the roads. The Interlocal agreement was discussed. Mayor Pro-Tem Andrea Colaizzi Miller stated we need to perform a culvert study.
2. **Building permits and Fees** – Mayor Pro-Tem Andrea Colaizzi Miller stated our current fees are being reviewed. The Council will continue to research what a beneficial fee schedule will look like for the city.
3. **Building Inspection Options** - Mayor Pro-Tem Andrea Colaizzi Miller stated there are different options for building inspections. After a lengthy discussion the Council concluded more research is needed.
4. **City Manager position** – Mayor Pro-Tem Andrea Colaizzi Miller started the discussion for the expectations of a City Manager. This item will need to be discussed further.
